After all, a month before, an avalanche had forced the couple to relocate their reception from a mountaintop site to a mountainside locale. But for the ski buffs, the perfect setting was one blanketed in shimmering powder. The weather gods obliged. "It started snowing huge, beautiful dry flakes that morning and didn't stop," recalls the bride. "It was spectacular!"
